D'Ambrosi foods only set up shop in 2020, with husband and wife duo Andrew and Jesse D'Ambrosi at the helm, and it's quickly become a firm favourite in the area. But this isn't your typical grab-and-go deli – after stints working in top [New York restaurants](#) and spending further time refining his skills in [France](#), Andrew decided to bring his quality cooking to Stow-on-the-Wold. Expect to find rotating seasonal salads such as roasted carrots with [honey](#) and coriander or creamy southern potato salad with smoked paprika and jalapeño dressing, while bigger American-inspired takeaways include fresh lobster rolls, fall-off-the-bone barbecue ribs and crispy fried chicken (which they've also recently served up at [Cotswold](#) pub favourite The Bell Inn in Langford).

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
